

## Level 3 results

We were pleased to see in the first year of the newly upgraded Level 3 qualifications, the Academy maintaining its strong position which resulted in its Post 16 provision being graded 'Good' by Ofsted in 2016. The student average grade improved by half a grade despite the more challenging expectations and students in vocational qualifications excelled with an average grade of a Distinction. The vast majority of all Post 16 courses achieved 100 per cent pass rates and Applied Science results were truly outstanding with 100% Distinction/Distinction Star and Sport with 90% Distinction/Distinction Star.

Extremely high achievers are as follows:-



**Robyn Allyn** 200 points – Double Distinction Star Applied Science, Double Distinction Business Studies and C A-Level Art.

**Carla Finn** 160 points – A grade in A-Level Health and Social Care B grades in A Level English Lit and Sociology and C grade in A-Level Biology

**Reece Eagles** 150 points – Double Distinction Star in Applied Science Distinction Star in Business Studies.

**Ashleigh Heath** 125 points – Double Distinction Star in Sport, Distinction in Public Services and B grade in A-Level Health and Social Care.

**Callum Penfold** 110 points – Distinction Star in Applied Science B grade in A-Level Health and Social Care and a D grade in A-Level Sociology.

The percentage of grades at B/A or equivalent was also notable at 29% across all qualifications. Our students are moving on to range of Universities including University of Kent and our sponsor Canterbury Christ Church University. We have been very pleased to have been supported with sixth form mentoring by CCCU which has undoubtedly contributed to our students' success.
