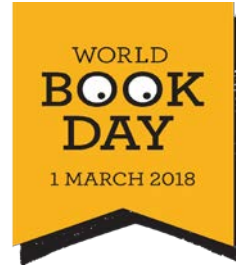

### World Book Day



On Thursday, 1 March we will be hosting a series of events in honour of World Book Day 2018. Students will participate in presentations, games and special assemblies about reading, books and authors. World Book Day is an annual event celebrated in schools. Its purpose is to raise awareness of the importance of reading to all students across all subjects, but additionally to encourage students to reflect on the sheer joy of reading a book.

Your son/daughter will receive a National Book Day voucher. These £1 vouchers can be redeemed against any book from all major supermarkets – Asda, Morrisons, Sainsbury's, most large bookshop chains – WH Smith, Waterstones, etc. and many independent booksellers. You will also have the opportunity to purchase specially selected books costing £1 (thus free if you present the World Book Day voucher) at the stores named above. At the bottom of this page there are images of just some of these £1 books available.

**This is an excellent opportunity to purchase books at a reduced price and to also explore with your son/daughter the wealth of enticing fiction and non-fiction books waiting to be enjoyed.
