

Year 7 Catch Up Premium Action Plan

2016-2017

Introduction

Year 7 Catch up Premium will be used to support **11%** of The Dover Christ Church Academy Y7 cohort in English and **13%** of the Y7 cohort in Mathematics (14 pupils in English. 17 pupils in Mathematics. 27 pupils Below standard in BOTH English and Mathematics).

- The school is to deliver tailored support to meet the Literacy & Numeracy needs of pupils who have not met the threshold score of 100 in either or both English and Mathematics and are deemed to be 'not secondary ready'.
- The school is expecting an allocation of approximately £16,000 for the academic year 2016-17.

Action Plan

The Year 7 Catch up Premium Report focuses on two strands with the aim of developing learners who are confident, engaged and making a minimum of 'expected' progress.
